

Hello to all my friends from South America



Thank you for continuing to follow the journey of what the Lord is doing here not only in Chile but in South America.

The past few months have been filled with so much growth in the Lord as a missionary and also so much joy in seeing the hand of the Lord at work in the lives of the people here.

In February of this year we did our first Vacation Bible School here in Chile at the local church I am apart of here called Calvary Chapel Iquique. Children from the community came as well as from our church family and many came to know Christ through this amazing week of ministry. I am specially thankful for my Calvary Chapel Golden Springs family who helped me put together ideas and format for our VBS.



In March we did our first big Whosoever's tour of the school year here in the south of Chile working with Calvary Chapel Temuco and Calvary Chapel Villarrica where we saw the youth from the public schools, detention centers, skate parks and our girls conference come to know Christ. What a beautiful week of serving the Lord that was.



My favorite event we did in the South of Chile was an event for 80 girls who came from several local schools to the town hall. At this event there were people from the mayors office and city council that came. And it was a great honor to share my book "Soy Hermosa" in Spanish with the girls and most of them that day including city officials gave their lives to Christ. One woman said "Jesus loved women and valued them." Smiling at her I said "Yes He did, and yes He does." Because in a community that had much abuse and brokenness, this woman saw the heart of Jesus and the love He has for women to redeem and rescue and save and restore their hearts and lives.



In April we launched our local school tours in the north of Chile where we are at, where we are continuing to see the youth come to Christ and get plugged into our local youth group and church here.

Today I leave for Colombia for a 13 day Whosoever's tour with our team where we will be going to 6 cities and bringing the gospel to the youth in the public schools, skate parks, detention centers and communities. I ask that you please be praying for our team and all that the Lord will do during this trip.

One of the biggest things I have seen here in South America is a hunger in the youth for the gospel. The youth are lost, hurting and broken. They are searching and when they come to find Christ through the simple message of the gospel many of them tell us “no one ever told us.”

With that statement “no one ever told us.” It speaks powerfully of the simple truth that the gospel is what the youth are hungry for and searching for. And all the Lord asks of us is to be messengers of His gospel and love to others. It’s nothing we say, it’s nothing we do, it’s all His spirit at work within us and through us.

Looking ahead to the next couple months we are praying and planning for our school tours in another city in the south of Chile, the second half of Colombia in August, Peru in September and also Brazil. To bring the gospel to the youth of not only our nation here in Chile but also all of South America.
